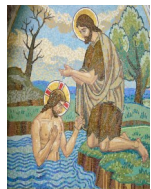

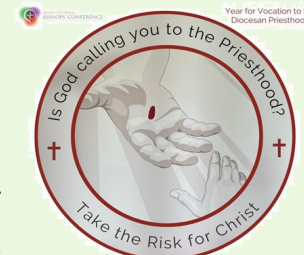


### EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION
