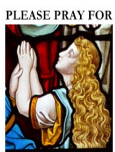

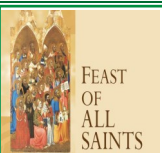

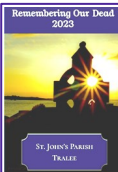

This Mass will also be live streamed for those unable to attend in person.



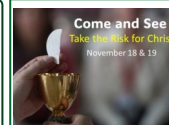
