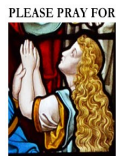

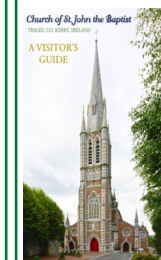


SPECIAL WEDDING JUBILEE

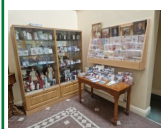
