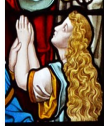

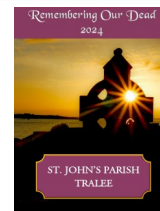

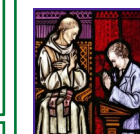
ST. JOHN'S CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD:
