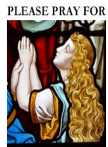

### REMEMBERING DECEASED COLLEAGUES & FRIENDS



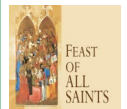

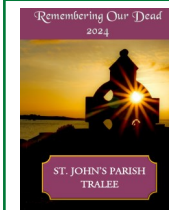
