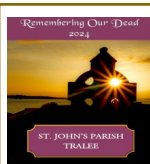
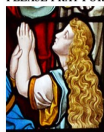

Vigil Mass to welcome the Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis. The Church will remain open till 12 midnight for veneration.

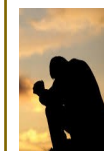
