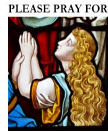

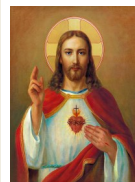

The **congregation** will follow the Blessed Sacrament **after Mass.**

The procession will go down to the main road, then along the side to the church to the rear carpark where Benediction will be held. Refreshments will be available after Benediction. Thanks to all whose cooperation makes our procession possible.

There will be a brief rehearsal for canopy bearers and the guard of honour on Thursday evening at 8pm.
