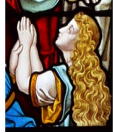

The group will be working in the biodiversity garden behind the church on Wednesdays from 10-11am until the end of August. Come to help or to say hello. Fáilte.

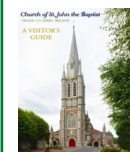


THE 3RD ANNUAL DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO KNOCK:
