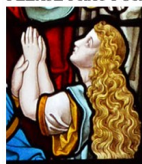

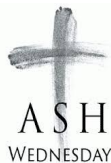

The Way of the Cross will be prayed every Wednesday during Lent (beginning Ash Wednesday) in St. John's Church at 5.40pm.

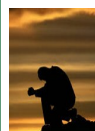
CAPITAL FUND ENVELOPES:
