FATHERS DAY PRAYER

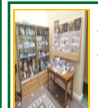

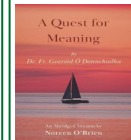
MIDSUMMER KERRY HEAD TURAS

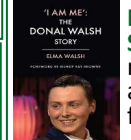
