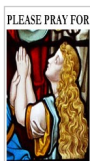

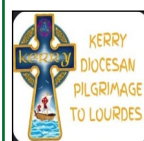
DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO KNOCK

Collins Steeplejacks have been appointed to undertake a further phase of remedial works to the spire/belltower and roof of St. John's Church. This phase will target historic, persistent roof leaks. The works will also include a detailed inspection of the spire, removal of vegetation growth and some localised masonry repairs. Work will commence on Monday 13th July 2026 for approx. 6 weeks, and will entail parking restrictions on the west side of the church, our apologies for any inconvenience caused.
